



### **Report on Blood Donation Camp**

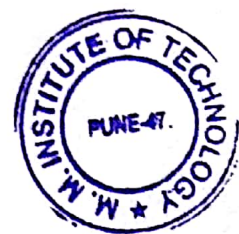
**Date:** 14<sup>th</sup> August 2018

A blood donation camp was organised by NSS unit in association with Gholap Blood Bank on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2018, Tuesday in the remembrance of 6<sup>th</sup> death anniversary of late Shri. Vilasrao Deshmukh. At the onset a tribute was paid to late Shri. Vilasrao Deshmukh, remembering his soul and great deeds. Principal Dr. R. V. Bhortake gave the keynote address followed by Mr. Gajanan Panchal (NSS Volunteer) who gave us a glimpse of late Shri. Vilasrao Deshmukh's life. Some of the staff also shared their experiences of working with late Mr. Vilasrao Deshmukh.

Late Shri. Vilasrao Deshmukh was born on 26 May 1945 in Babhalgaon in Latur district in Maharashtra. He entered active politics and became a member of the Babhalgaon (Latur) Village Panchayat from 1974 to 1980 and it's Sarpanch (village chief) from 1974 to 1976. As the President of Osmanabad District Youth Congress from 1975 to 1978, he worked for the implementation of the Sanjay Gandhi inspired Five Point Programme of the Youth Congress. He was a Member of the Maharashtra Legislative Assembly from 1980 to 1995 winning the 1980, 1985, and 1990 elections. During this period, he served as the Minister of State and the Cabinet Minister and had the portfolios of the ministries of Home, General Administration, Cooperation, Public Works, Transport, Legislative Affairs, Tourism, Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development Fisheries, Industry, Rural Development, Education, Technical Education, Sports and Youth Welfare. He became the Chief Minister of Maharashtra on 18 October 1999. He died the on 14 August 2012 due to an apparent multiple organ failure.







Everybody observed two minutes of silence in honour of Late Shri. Vilasrao Deshmukh's soul. At 11:00 am the blood donation camp began in which dozens of student's voluntarily donated blood for this great cause for saving someone's life.
