7.3. Institutional Distinctiveness

‘Marathwada Mitra Mandal, Pune’ is a trust established in the year 1967 with the motto " Yethe Bahutanche Hita " (Welfare of Masses). The watchwords of trust are Mass education, co-education, and dedication toward the overall development of the students. This trust is well known for its student-centric policies and for providing quality education with affordable fees.

The institution has the vision “Techno-Social Excellence”. Along with the necessary academic and technical knowledge in different disciplines, emphasis is given to nurturing graduates with a reasonable sense of social responsibility. Most of the admitted students are from economically weak backgrounds and a significant number of open-category students are from farmer’s families (more than 60%). Amongst these, few students are not eligible for Government free ship and scholarship. Several deserving students are on the verge of quitting their education because of weak financial conditions every year.

The trust and the Institution take the responsibility of continuing the education of such needy students through financial assistance and providing them an opportunity to become successful engineer.
