3	Students Students	Non-availability of internet, mobile connectivity on some occassions, students miss the online lectures.	The live online sessions conducted during regular teaching were recorded and these video lectures were shared to students through Google Classroom
		Physical access to college library was not feasible during pandemic.	Faculties shared e-books to students through Google Classroom. A vast database of e-books made available to students through NDL (National Digital Library) and DELNET platform.

		Need to make freshly admitted students feel comfortable in their new environment, set a healthy daily routine, create bonding in the batch as well as between faculty and students as per the guidelines of AICTE.	Induction program for freshly admitted students of first year and direct second was conducted in online mode.

Also, Pune being one of the worst affected cities in number of covid cases, many activities could not be conducted. There is limitation of online teaching which lacks practical skills and hands-on experiences.
